The European Commission hereby awards this Charter to:
IES Universidad Laboral

The institution undertakes to respect the following principles:

- Respect for the principles of non-discrimination set out in the Programme and ensure equal access and opportunities to mobile participants from all backgrounds.
- Ensure full integration for successfully completed activities of study, mobility and, where possible, traineeship in terms of credits awarded (ECTS or compatible system). Ensure the inclusion of substantially completed ECTS and/or traineeship mobility activities in the final record of student achievements (Diploma Supplement or equivalent).
- Charge no fees, in the case of credit mobility, to incoming mobile students for tuition, registration, examination or other administrative activities.

The institution further undertakes to:

- **- When Participating in Mobility Activities -**
 - **Before Mobility**
 - Publish and update, under the central catalogue on the website of the institution, well in advance of the mobility periods, so as to be transparent to all centres and allow mobile students to make well-informed choices about the charter they will follow.
 - Carry out mobility only within the framework of prior agreements between institutions. These agreements establish the respective roles and responsibilities of the different parties, as well as their commitment to shared quality criteria to the enrolment, integration, support and integration of mobile participants.
 - Ensure that outgoing mobile participants are well prepared for the mobility, including having attained the minimum level of language proficiency.
 - Ensure that student and staff mobility for education/training purposes is based on a learning agreement for students and a mobility agreement for staff, established in advance between the home and host institutions or enterprises and the mobile participants.
 - Provide assistance related to obtaining visas, when required, for training and lodging mobile participants.
 - Provide assistance related to obtaining insurance, when required, for training and lodging mobile participants.
 - Provide guidance to incoming mobile participants in finding accommodation.

During Mobility

- Ensure good academic equipment and services for home students and staff and incoming mobile participants.
- Integrate incoming mobile participants into the institution's everyday life.
- Have in place appropriate mentoring and support arrangements for mobile participants.
- Provide appropriate language support to incoming mobile participants.

After Mobility

- Assess all activities included in the learning agreement in a monitoring framework, the degree provided there have been satisfactorily completed by the mobile students.
- Provide learning mobility participants and their host institutions with training files containing a full, accurate and timely record of their achievements at the end of their mobility period.
- Support the reintegration of mobile participants and promote the opportunity, upon return, to build on their experience for the benefit of the institution and their peers.
- Ensure that staff are given recognition for their teaching and training activities undertaken during the mobility period based on a mobility agreement.

- When Participating in European and International Cooperation Projects -

- Ensure that cooperation leads to sustainable and balanced outcomes for all partners.
- Ensure that incoming staff, students and mobile participants are supported in their activities.
- Report the results of the projects in a way that will recognise their impact on individuals and participating institutions and encourage peer learning with the wider academic community.

- For the Purposes of Visibility -

- Display this Charter and the related Erasmus Policy Statement prominently on the institution's website.
- Promote consistently activities supported by the Programme, along with their results.

On behalf of the institution, I confirm that implementation of the Charter will be consistent and that adoption of one of the above principles and commitments may lead to its withdrawal by the European Commission.



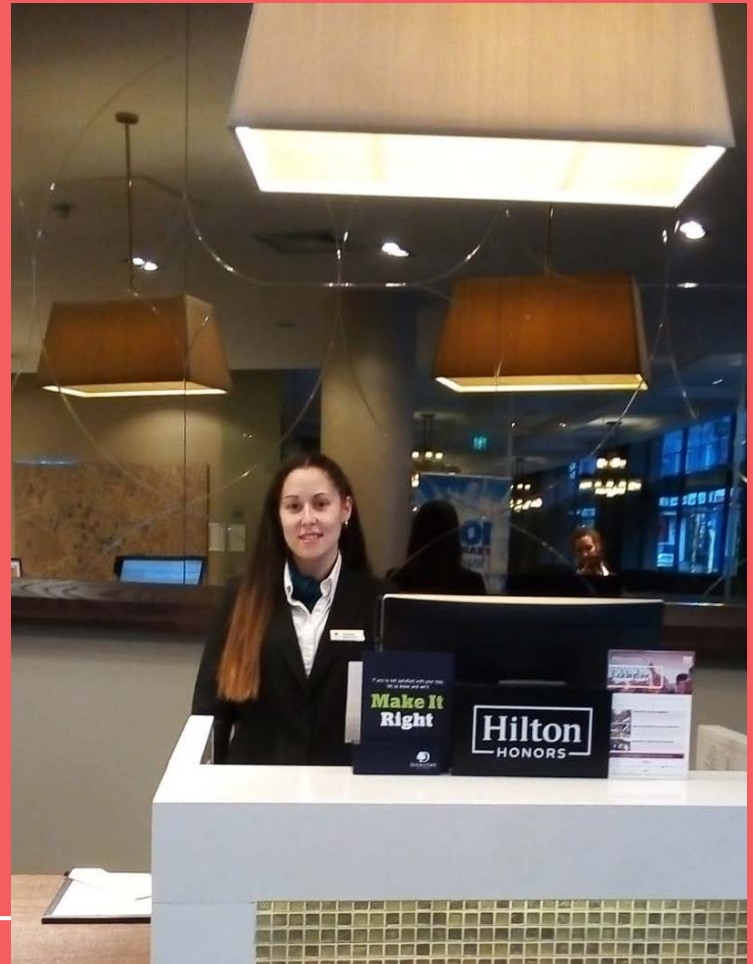
