Why?

The Romanian National Agency would like to highlight the impact of European funded projects (LLP - Comenius, Leonardo da Vinci, Erasmus + and POS-DRU – human resources development) on educational and vocational guidance for pupils (including pupils with special educational needs or from disadvantaged social backgrounds), on combating school early leaving or continuing their education through the "Second chance" program and on promoting access to the national and the European labour market.

What?

The participants will improve their knowledge on:

- educational policies aiming at school and vocational guidance and training (including pupils with SEN);
- local/county impact of educational projects funded by EU implemented in the county Botosani;



- customized paths for pupils with special educational needs and early school leavers (examples of good practice in the implemented projects);
- Validation of skills acquired through European education programmes and projects - Europass
- Mobility Portfolio and the Europass Mobility document.

How?

Participants will:

- visit schools that have developed European educational projects and other educational institutions (university, CJRAE) or relevant companies in the county;
- attend lectures and debates on topics concerning school and vocational guidance; participate in dissemination/valorization activities of European educational projects implemented;
- they will meet officials from the field of education, teachers, pupils, local and county representatives, representatives of various local businesses .

Cost

This activity is financed by the Erasmus+ Programme. Being selected for this activity, all costs (event fee, accommodation, travel, visa, etc.) relevant to participation in the seminar will be covered by the National Agencies involved in this project.

You may be asked to cover travel costs in advance and they will be reimbursed after your return, once you have provided Spanish NA with the documentation and a final report.
