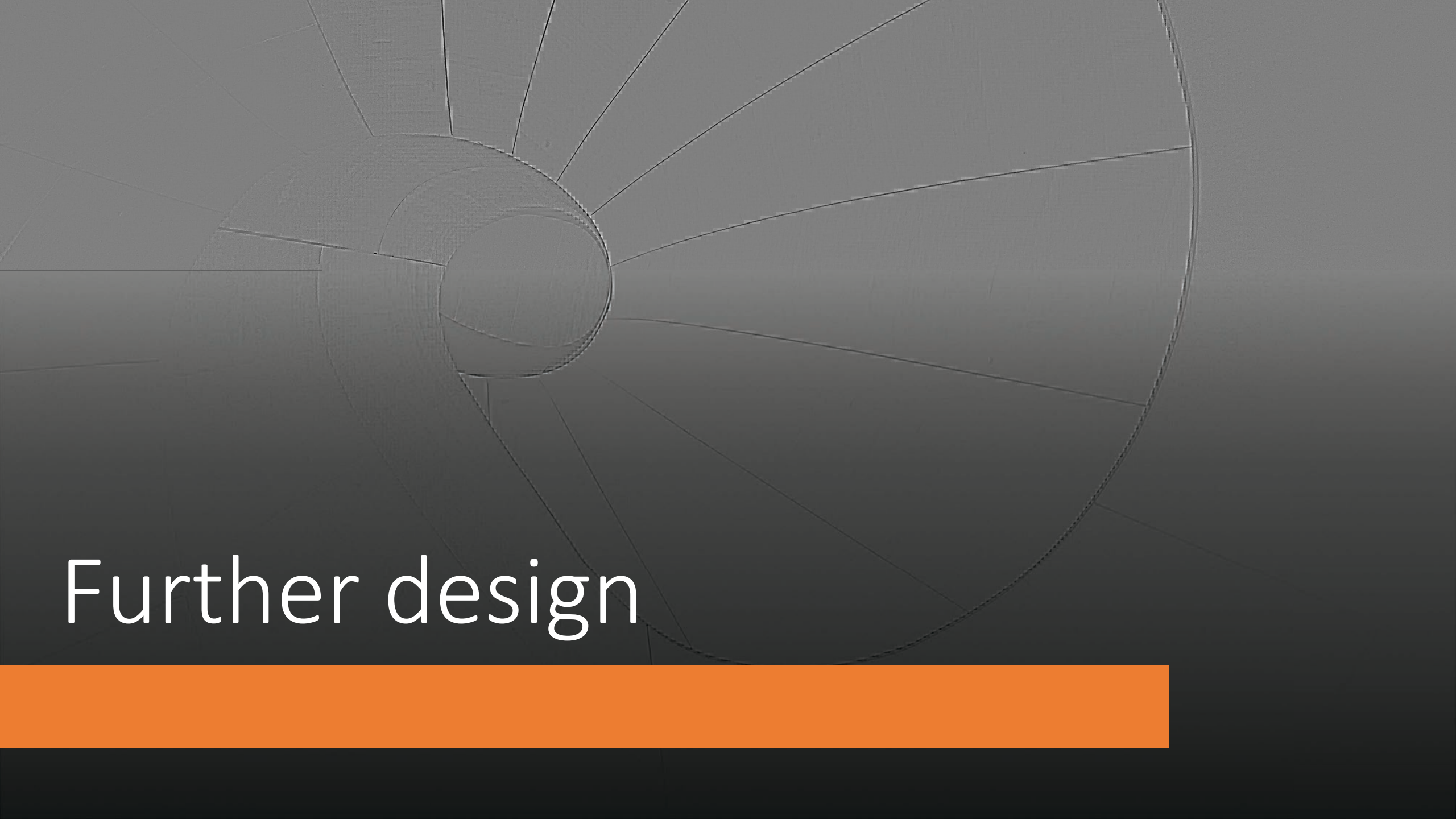

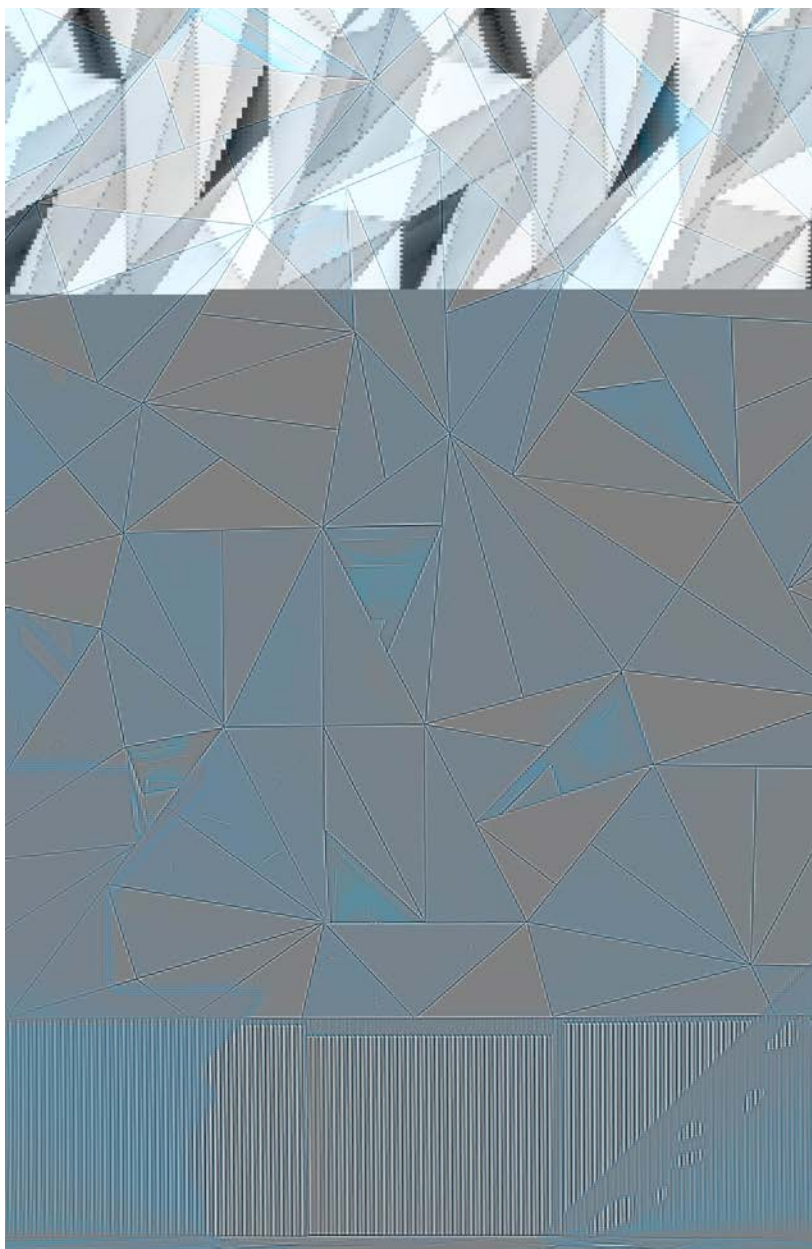

What are the functions of the Erasmus Dashboard?

The Erasmus Dashboard is a space to manage your outgoing and incoming students: review, decline, comment, download and sign their LAs online.

It also doubles as a communication platform with our exchange students, easily letting you send group email notifications and push notifications to users of the **Erasmus+ App**. You can also add deadlines and specific information about your HEI that will be displayed in the Erasmus+ Step-by-Step guides on the Erasmus+ App.

Welcome to the Erasmus Dashboard Help Center!

Even though the EU funding for the EWP project officially ended on 31.12.2019, the core project team has remained active ever since, working to ensure that both the EWP Network and Dashboard remain available to more than 850 and 2300 higher education institutions respectively. In 2020 we have also deployed new APIs and online services and ensured that the rapid increase in the number of connections to this infrastructure was achieved without difficulties. We also made a major effort to tend to more than 3000 emails and support requests.

The rapid growth of EWP and the fact that personalized support to users is a very resource-intensive task means that we do not have the capacity to continue to operate this service to the desired extent, and would like to invite users to refer to the EWP Competence Centre, where most relevant information can already be found. In the meantime, we will continue to strive for resources to be allocated to enabling the kind of support that the Erasmus+ community undoubtedly deserves.

The EWP teams remain strongly committed to the success of this initiative and the ESCI as a whole. We will continue to marshal our own resources and voluntary work to cover the costs of keeping the EWP Network, Dashboard and Competence Centre available free of charge for the foreseeable future.
